

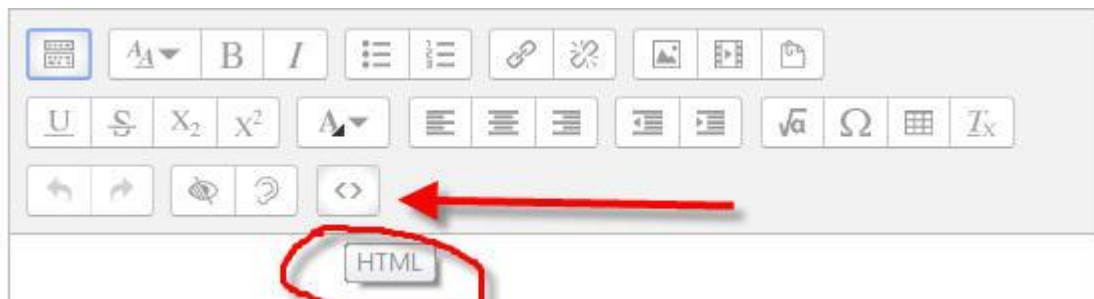
# Printing a Quiz

Many ask how to print a quiz for students in need of a paper quiz. We now have a method of accomplishing this.

1. Turn Editing On for your course.
2. Click Add an activity or resource in the topic section of your choosing.
3. Select the Book Resource from the list.
4. Type in a name for the Book and Click Save and display.
5. Type in the Chapter title ( Quiz name here would be great)
6. Under the Content area, click the expand settings icon.



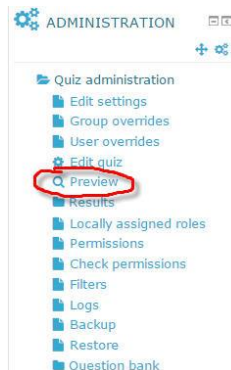
7. Then click the HTML source button.



8. Copy the following code and paste it into the content area:

```
<iframe src = "QUIZ_link.html" width="100%" height="1500">

</iframe>
```

9. Next, in another browser tab, open the quiz you wish to insert.
10. Under Course administration, Click on Preview to view the quiz.



11. Copy the URL for this quiz. For example:

<https://courses.centre.edu/mod/quiz/attempt.php?attempt=62279>


12. Return to the browser tab with your Moodle Book module.

13. Paste the link listed above between the “ ” in the code, replacing the Quiz\_link.html.

14. Click the HTML source button again.

15. Your content will now look like this:
