

Terminology

Listed below are the basic terminologies when using the settings on the touch panel.

- **PC Main** - Desktop located at instructor podium
- **PC Ext. Desktop 1** - allows side and rear sources to become additional monitors for content overflow from PC Main.
- **PC Ext. Desktop 2** - allows side and rear sources to become additional monitors for content overflow from PC Main and PC Ext. Desktop 1.
- **Solstice** - wireless presentation device
- **Solstice main** - wireless presentation device for projecting to all sources
- **Solstice local** - wireless presentation device to connect to side and rear sources
- **Doc cam** - displays real-time images and content
- **Vid Mute** - turns off video feed to projector source
- **A/V Mute** - turns off video/audio feed to rear and side sources
- **Power Control** - options to turn off sources you will not use during this session
- **Source Routing** - screen where all devices and sources are listed
- **System Off** - screen where you turn off the system

Each button on the touch panel corresponds with a "device". Each of the columns represent a separate source to which these devices can send a signal.
